ORDINANCE NO. 229

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 39 TO EXTEND THE EXISTING
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DETROIT AND CONSUMERS POWER, INC., FOR AN
ADDITIONAL TEN YEARS**

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of November, 1977, the City of Detroit passed Ordinance 39 which was the grant of a franchise to Consumer Power, Inc. for the purpose of using the City right-of-way to provide electrical power within the city limits of Detroit: and,

WHEREAS, on the 9th of September, 2003 Ordinance 194 amended Ordinance 39 to extend the Franchise Agreement for an additional ten (10) years under the same terms and conditions except for an increase in the franchise fee.

WHEREAS, the City and consumers Power, Inc, desire to continue the franchise agreement for an additional ten (10) years under the same terms and conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DETROIT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Ordinance 39 is amended by striking the language in Section 4 and replacing it with the following Language;

“This franchise is granted until September 9, 2023, unless sooner terminated as provided in this franchise”.

SECTION 2. Except as specifically amended herin, Ordinance 39 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council

Second reading by title before the City Council of the City of Detroit on September 10, 2013.


