

ORDINANCE NO. 240

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 236
THE ATV ORDINANCE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of May, 2015, the City of Detroit passed Ordinance No. 236, an Ordinance Authorizing the operation of Class I and Class IV All-Terrain Vehicles on certain streets located within the boundaries of the City of Detroit; and

WHEREAS, the Detroit City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Detroit to amend Ordinance No. 236 to better follow State Law Regulations regarding the helmet requirement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DETROIT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Number 8 - Helmet Requirements is hereby amended by removing the following text:
“Any person operating or riding as passenger must wear a motorcycle helmet with a fastened chin strap while on an ATV operated under this ordinance”,
- Number 8 To Read – “Youth under 18 must wear a DOT approved helmet with the chin strap fastened while on an ATV operated under this ordinance”.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.

First read before the City Council of the City of Detroit on October 13, 2015
Second reading by title before the City Council of the City of Detroit on October 13, 2015.
