GOOD NEWS! The Marion County Public Works Department has informed us that on Thursday October 15, 2020 they will be bring a truck with potable water to Detroit for home use. They cannot give an exact time they will arrive due to some training from the Department of Health.

Due to current health care standards in place only Marion County personal will need to be on hand to help with water dispersal, and so people should not expect to get water at all times. The Public Works Department is working on ways to make the process more convenient, but for now residents are asked to understand they had to agree to the system being implemented to start this service as fast as possible.
