

PUBLIC NOTICE Office of State Fire Marshal to Hold Virtual Public Hearing The Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal will be conducting a Virtual public hearing to hear comments regarding a proposed conditional use fueling facility located at 1477 N Santiam Hwy, Idanha, OR 97350.

This virtual public hearing will be held on February 25, 2021 at 1:00 PM. Marc Nelson Oil Products has applied to transfer their existing Nonretail Fueling (Cardlock) facility license in Idanha to a conditional use fueling facility license, which will allow local residents who sign agreements with Marc Nelson Oil Products to dispense Class 1 flammable liquids. Cardlock conditional use facility licenses are for areas where the nearest retail gas station is more than seven miles from the proposed facility. The hearing allows residents, and local government authorities to provide testimony in support or opposition of the proposed conditional use facility. The hearing is open to all interested parties and residents.

Our office has established multiple methods to provide testimony:

NOTE: You do not need Microsoft Teams to join the virtual hearing.
