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- 1. CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Trett called the meeting to order at 6:39 PM.

**7. RESOLUTIONS, ORDERS AND ADMISTRATIVE ACTION**

- A. REPLACEMENT FENCING FOR CITY PARK-** Michele Tesdal says we have received 3 bids. We do not have to be concerned about prevailing wage because we are not using government money to pay for it. The bid from Creekside fencing was \$18,000 and could be done around Labor Day, F & W Fence bid was \$15,200 and also could be done around Labor Day, and University Fencing lowered their bid by \$1.00 a foot so the current bid is \$15,070 and they could be started by the third week of July. Michele Tesdal made a motion to accept the University Fencing & Home Improvements of Albany bid to place fencing on the north side of the Detroit City Park, seconded by Todd Smith. Todd Smith is concerned about some residents that have trees on the other side of the fence that could possibly jeopardize the fence. Todd Smith made a friendly amendment that we approve the University Fencing & Home Improvements to replace the north side fence of Detroit City park for \$15,070 assessing that there are no problems with placing the fence there and addressing a dead tree that's on private property. Part of this is being paid by City insurance. All in favor, motion passed unanimously.
- B. RESOLUTION 642 – Hazard Mitigation Grant –** Eric Page made a motion to approve Resolution 642 to accept an HMG grant from the Federal government, seconded by Todd Smith, all in favor, motion passed unanimously.
- C. IGA between Marion County and the City of Detroit –** Eric Page made a motion to accept the IGA between Marion County and Detroit, seconded by Todd Smith, all in favor motion passed unanimously.

- 8. ADJOURNMENT –** Eric Page made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Denny Nielsen, motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:04 PM.
