

Detroit – Idanha Power Outage Information

The power outage affecting the Detroit – Idanha area has been caused by wildfire burning in the Maupin area in Central Oregon. The fire has tripped off a major transmission line of the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). The outage is affecting a “very large area” NOT just the Santiam Canyon.

Consumers Power Incorporated (CPI) is working with the BPA to figure out how to reroute power to those area affected by the outage. Meanwhile CPI crews are also driving their power lines to make sure that their lines are OK and operational.

BPA does not a have a time estimate to re-establish power.
