

The City of Detroit will hold public hearings on **Thursday, April 18** at 6:30 p.m. (before Planning Commission) regarding the adoption of proposed updates to the Detroit Development Code under city case file LA-2022-01. This is an entire Code updates making updates to several sections of the Code.

The City of Detroit has determined that adoption of these updates, via ordinance, may affect the permissible uses of your property, and other properties in the affected zone, and may change the value of your property. *According to Chapter 4 of the Detroit Development Code a recommendation by the Planning Commission to the City Council and then the final decision by the City Council shall be based on consideration of approval criteria. These include:

- 1. The Statewide Planning Goals and Guidelines adopted under Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 197 (for comprehensive plan amendments only);
- 2. Comments from any applicable federal or state agencies regarding applicable statutes or regulations;
- 3. Any applicable intergovernmental agreements; and
- 4. Any applicable comprehensive plan policies and provisions of this Code that implement the comprehensive plan. Compliance with Chapter 4.7 shall be required for Comprehensive Plan Amendments, and Land Use Zone Map and Text Amendments.

Notice requirements are described in the 4.1.7.D.* A staff report will be available for review one week prior to the first hearing. Hearing procedure for a legislative amendment is described in Detroit Development Code subsection 4.1.7.F.
