

ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ENTIRE PORTION OF SOUTH DETROIT AVENUE LOCATED IN PATTON THIRD ADDITION.

The City of Detroit, Oregon ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1. Purpose.** The Detroit City Council has determined that owners consent has been obtained, notice has been duly given, and the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of the entire portion of South Detroit Avenue in the Patton Third Addition; therefore the city is in favor, and shall vacate this street.

**SECTION 2. Severability.** Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase; and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held to be invalid on one ground, but valid on another it shall be construed that the valid ground is the one upon which the ordinance, or such portion thereof was enacted.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect on the thirtieth day after its enactment.

Read first in full and by title only at the council meeting on May 11, 1993, and read a second time by title only at the council meeting on the 11th day of May, 1993. Passed by a vote of 3 ayes and 0 nays of the City Council this 11th day of May, 1993.
