

ORDINANCE NO. 141

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ZONE CHANGE AT 225 W FOREST AVENUE

The City of Detroit, Oregon" ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose: Upon motion duly made and passed at a public hearing on October 24, 1995, property tax lot number 66995-000, is hereby changed from schools/parks to public zoning.

SECTION 2. Severability: Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause of phrase; and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held to be invalid on one ground but valid on another, it shall be construed that the valid ground is the one upon which the ordinance or such portion thereof was enacted.

SECTION 3. Emergency Clause: It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Detroit, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect when signed by the mayor.

Read in full and by title only this 24th day of October, 1995.

Read a second time by title only this 24 day of October, 1995.

Passed by Council with a unanimous vote and approved by the Mayor this 24 day of October, 1995.

Section 4. Penalties

Violations of a provision of this ordinance is punishable as set forth in the Detroit Enforcement Ordinance.

Section 5. Severability

Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not effect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase; and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held invalid on one ground but valid on another it shall be construed that the valid ground is the one upon which the ordinance or such portion thereof was enacted.

Section 6. Emergency Clause

This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the council and its approval by the mayor.


