

ORDINANCE NO. 143

AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE USE OF EXHAUST BRAKES, JAKE BRAKES OR OTHER SIMILAR NOISE PRODUCING STOPPING DEVICES, EXEMPTING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.

The City of Detroit ordains as follows:

Section 1. Unlawful Acts

With the exception of use during an emergency situation no person shall use exhaust brakes, jake brakes or similar noise producing stopping devices within the city limits.

Section 2. Penalties

Violations of a provision of this ordinance is punishable as set forth in the Detroit Enforcement Ordinance.

Section 3. Severability

Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not effect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase; and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held invalid on one ground but valid on another it shall be construed that the valid ground is the one upon which the ordinance or such portion thereof was enacted.

Section 4. Emergency Clause

This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the council and its approval by the mayor.


