

ORDINANCE # 165

AN AMENDMENT TO THE DETROIT ZONING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 2,
SECTION 2.02

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the City of Detroit to establish a minimum size for stick built dwelling units, the definition for dwelling units shall read:


Dwelling Unit: One or more habitable rooms which are occupied or which are intended or designed to be occupied by one family with facilities for living, sleeping, cooking, and eating, and being at least 700 square feet in size, 400 Square Foot, Foot print buildings will be acceptable, so long as they meet the square footage requirement.
