ORDINANCE # 166

**ORDINANCE TO REGULATE VEHICLE USAGE ON OR OVER THE  
STREETS OF THE CITY OF DETROIT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Detroit finds it necessary to regulate vehicle usage on the streets of the city to prevent damage caused by heavy vehicles and heavy loads driven over them and in an attempt to regulate the use of the streets of the City of Detroit by all vehicular traffic, and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds an emergency to exist,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED**, by the City Council of the City of Detroit:

1. All vehicles utilizing the streets, roadways and public ways of Detroit, except as listed herein: Highway 22, Detroit Avenue, Clester, West Forest, D Street, Santiam Avenue from Highway 22 to Detroit Avenue, and North Patton to Third and Erin as they presently are designated and as they presently exist, which are two axles or more and having a gross vehicle weight according to manufactures specifications in excess of 30 thousand pounds, prior to being operated on the streets and public ways of the City of Detroit shall secure form the City Recorder a permit prior to their operation over and across and upon the streets and public ways of the City of Detroit bearing any load.
2. Prior to the issuance of any permit by the City Recorder, the applicant shall provide the make of the vehicle, type of vehicle, gross weight, registration number, load carrying capacity, owner's name and address, operators name and address, if different from the owner, and the type of load proposed to be carried and the duration of use of any vehicle or combination of vehicles.
3. A speed of limit of fifteen (15) miles per hour is hereby imposed upon all vehicles utilizing the streets, roads, and public byways of the City of Detroit who meet the requirements of Paragraph 1 herein above.
4. The street in the City of Detroit known as Highway 22 shall be exempt from this ordinance regardless of weight. All vehicles regardless of weight may utilize this road. The Streets in the City of Detroit known as Detroit Avenue and Clester Road shall be exempt from this ordinance for delivery trucks only.
5. That any person who is a legal resident of the City of Detroit may travel over any street or roadway in the City of Detroit and operate a vehicle having a gross vehicle weight according to the manufacturers specifications in excess of 30,000 pounds when it becomes necessary to drive said vehicle to the

residence of said person, in situations where said person who operates the vehicle is loaded and can not unload his vehicle, and therefore may keep said vehicle at his residence, but such allowed overnight parking may not exceed 12 consecutive hours in a 24 hour period on any property. At no time may vehicles be parked on City Streets.

6. Emergency vehicles, including but not limited to fire trucks, ambulances and school buses are exempt form the provisions of this ordinance.

7. Any violation of this ordinance shall result in the imposition of a fine in the amount of \$150.00 (one hundred and fifty dollars)

8. There will be no charge for first 5 loads per month, each load thereafter will be charged \$25.00 per load.

This ordinance shall become in full force and effect on its passage by the Council of the City of Detroit, Oregon on the day of December 1998.
