

AN ORDINANCE PREVENTING THE ABANDONMENT OF VEHICLES, PARTS THEREOF, OR OBSTRUCTIVE OBJECTS ON CITY PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Detroit ordains as follows:

- 21-1 It shall be unlawful to abandon, deposit, or store any obstructive or unsightly object or objects on city property without consent or at the direction of the common council.
- 21-2 After a period of five days, the common council, may direct removal or disposal thereof and any cost involved may be assessed to the owner or owners.
- 21-3 Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city of Detroit, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
