

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFERRING OF UNSPENT DESIGNATED FUNDS IN THE GENERAL FUND TO AN UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE IN GENERAL FUND.

The City of Detroit, Oregon ordains as follows:

Due to an existing emergency to complete the budget for 1964-65.

I request that the Mayor declare an emergency and adopt Ordinance No. 27.

Transferring the unspent designated funds in the General Fund to an unappropriated balance in General Fund.

It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Detroit and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
