



ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE PREVENTING THE PARKING AND STORAGE OF VEHICLES ON STREETS OR PROPERTY OF THE CITY, THEREBY OBSTRUCTING THE ORDERLY CLEARING OF SNOW FROM THE CITY STREETS AND PROPERTY AND CREATING A HAZARD, PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFORE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DETROIT, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- 37-1. It shall be illegal to park, or store a vehicle on streets or property of the City when said vehicle is parked or stored in a manner causing obstruction and hazard to traffic and the orderly and proper clearing of snow from the City streets or property.
- 37-1A. And it shall be further illegal to park vehicles on Oregon Highway #22 between 50 feet West of the westerly leg of Breitenbush Rd. intersection and Santiam Ave. and to all city street intersections within the city limits, when said vehicle or vehicles are parked in a manner causing an obstruction and hazard to traffic and the orderly flow of traffic.
- 37-2. It shall be illegal to abandon a vehicle on City streets or property.
Vehicle held in violation of section 1, and which vehicle does not have properly signed receipt of registration attached to a prominent place inside vehicle, shall be declared abandoned.
An abandoned vehicle as defined in section 2, may be removed by order of the common council of the City of Detroit, without prior notice to owner.
- 37-3 A vehicle held in violation of section 1, or section 2 or both, may be removed and impounded by order of the Common Council, provided owner has been notified of violation not less than six hours prior to removal for impoundment. Notice of violation may be given in writing, verbally, or by telephone.
Owner of vehicle held in violation of section 1, or section 2 or both, may be fined not to exceed \$100.00 plus cost of removal
- 37-4 An owner may claim and recover an impounded vehicle by showing documented identification and paying of fine plus cost of removal, to the City Recorder.
An owner or his representative who removes an impounded vehicle, without written and signed permission from the City Recorder, will be prosecuted on a separate charge.
Vehicles not claimed within thirty days from date of impoundment may be sold by the City of Detroit to recover amount of fine and cost of removal.
Vehicles or parts thereof considered not saleable, and not claimed within thirty days from date of impoundment, may be disposed of by dumping.
