

ORDINANCE NO. 53

An ORDINANCE, regulating and prohibiting parking and declaring penalties.

The City of Detroit ordains as follows:

Section 1. In addition to the areas where parking is prohibited by state motor vehicle laws, parking is limited to 72 hours in the following areas and places: City Streets, all City right of way, leaving a minimum of 3 feet clearance on each side of private driveways.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of or operated by such person to be parked in violation of this ordinance.

Section 3. A vehicle parked over 72 hours is in violation of this ordinance and may be removed and impounded by order of the Common Council. Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than \$1.00 or not more than \$100.00.


Section 4. No vehicle that has been impounded as herein provided shall be released unless the cost of impoundment shall have been paid.

Section 5. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council by unanimous vote and approved by the Mayor this 14th day of August 1973.
