Section 1. Ordinance 33 of the City of Detroit entitled: "AN ORDINANCE providing for the administration of the water department of the City of Detroit, Oregon:

Providing Rules and Regulations, setting rates and charges, providing penalties, and declaring an emergency, is hereby amended by adding the following to Paragraph 3 thereof:

(e) ANNUAL RATES FOR WATER WITHIN THE CITY AS SET FORTH

Houses, cabins, dwelling units and connections for dwelling units; including but not limited to connections for campers, trailers and mobile homes . . .	\$ 60.00/year
United States Post Office and Telephone Office . .	60.00/year
Schools	500.00/year
Laundromat	200.00/year
Taverns with Restaurant Facilities	200.00/year
Resorts, Trailer Courts, Motels	
Offices and permanently occupied units	60.00/year
Trailer spaces, motel units rented on a transient basis	20.00/year
All other business	100.00/year
