

ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TAX BASE OF \$9,250.00 TO BE ESTABLISHED FOR THE CITY OF DETROIT, OREGON, SUBMITTING SUCH TAX BASE TO THE REGISTERED LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF DETROIT FOR THEIR APPROVAL OR REJECTION AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 5, 1974, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Detroit has experienced recent unexpected financial expenses; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a tax base of \$9,350.00 in lieu of \$2,538.90 in order for the City to meet its obligations and to maintain its water system and care for its other business; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish such a tax base it is necessary that the matter be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Detroit, for their rejection or approval.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF DETROIT:

- 1 - \$9,250.00 is established as the tax base of the City of Detroit, subject to the approval of registered legal voters of the City as hereafter provided.
- 2 - That the City of Detroit, Marion County, Oregon, call an election to be held at the Detroit City Hall on the 5th day of November, 1974, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of the City, the question of establishing a tax base of \$9,250.00.
- 3 - That the following named persons be and they are hereby appointed as the election board for such election:
Beth Thomason, Chairman, Marion VanBelt, Clerk,
and Richard Kouri, Clerk.
- 4 - That the recorder be directed to cause the ballot title to be printed in proper form on the ballot to be used at the said election and to perform all other acts necessary to properly submit said ordinance for establishing \$9,250.00 as a tax base for the City in lieu of \$2,538.90 or any other amount to the qualified legal voters of the City.


