

ORDINANCE # 69

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance #47 of the City of Detroit entitled:

AN ORDINANCE creating a planning commission and providing for its organization, its powers and duties.

The City of Detroit ordains as follows:

Section 47-1 to be amended to include: Two members of any family may be allowed to be on the planning commission at the same time; however, only one member of the same family may vote on an issue being considered, and one member must abstain from voting. "FAMILY" to be defined as: Those who descend from a common progenitor as father, mother, children, or any group of blood relatives; and to also include any collective body of persons who live in one house and under one head, including relatives by blood and by marriage.

This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in effect on March 12, 1980, after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Common Council of the City of Detroit, Oregon this 11 day of March 1980.
