ORDINANCE # 73

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 29 RELATING TO NUISANCES.

THE CITY OF DETROIT, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 29-3 is amended to read:

Animals running at large. No owner or other person in charge of any dog, livestock, or other animal shall permit such dog, livestock, or other animal to run loose or be at large in the city. This section shall not apply to dogs which are subject to control by Marion County Dog Control (ORS 609.015(2)).

Section 29-15(2)(a), relating to acts declared to constitute unnecessary noise in violation of the ordinance, is amended to read:

The keeping of any fowl or animal which makes any loud, unusual, frequent or repeated noise which disturbs the peace and quiet of any part of the city, or annoys any person in the vicinity. This section shall not apply to dogs which are subject to control by Marion County Dog Control (ORS 609.015)

This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is declared to exist. This Ordinance shall be in effect on August 11, 1981 after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.

Read in entirety before the Common Council of the City of Detroit, Oregon on July 14, 1981.

Read second time before the Common Council of the City of Detroit, Or. on August 11, 1981.

Passed unanimously by the Common Council on August 11, 1981.

Approved by the Mayor August 11, 1981.
