AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE #11 regulating speed limits within the city:

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE SPEED OF AUTOMOBILES, TRUCKS, MOTORCYCLES, ON STREETS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF DETROIT, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Detroit Ordains as follows:

- 11-1 The speed of motor vehicles, as automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, shall be limited to a speed not to exceed ten (10) miles per hour on gravel roads and fifteen (15) miles per hour on paved streets within the city limits of Detroit, Oregon.
- 11-2 Signs designating the speed limit shall be posted at the entrance to each major area on the main area thoroughfare.
- 11-3 This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Detroit, and an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force when signed by the Mayor.
