

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF CITY ATTORNEYS, PRESCRIBING THE QUALIFICATIONS THEREFOR, DEFINING THE DUTIES THEREOF, PROVIDING THE COMPENSATION THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Detroit ordains as follows:

8-1 There is hereby created the office of City Attorney.

8-2 The City Attorney shall be an active member of the Oregon State Bar in good standing.

8-3 The duties of the City Attorney shall include the following matters:

- ~~(a) Preparation of ordinances and resolutions.~~ Deleted per Ord. #99 <sup>attached</sup> amendment
- (b) The rendering of legal advice to the city council when so requested, and at such other times as the City Attorney may consider appropriate.
- (c) Assisting with the prosecution in the Municipal Court of persons charged with violations of city ordinances.

8-4 For the performance of the duties heretofore mentioned in Section 3 of this ordinance, the City Attorney shall receive as compensation such remuneration as the city council may, from time to time authorize.

8-5 In addition to the duties specifically mentioned in Section 3 of this ordinance, the City Attorney shall, when requested by the city council, represent and appear for the City of Detroit, or its officials, in any matter or cause pending in the County Court, the Circuit Court, the Supreme Court, or before any board commission or legislative committee, and as compensation for such services he shall receive such sum or sums as may be mutually agreed upon between himself and the city council.

8-6 It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Detroit, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
