

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE SPEED OF AUTOMOBILES, TRUCKS, MOTORCYCLES ON POSTED STREETS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF DETROIT, OREGON TO A SPEED NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY MILES PER HOUR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The city of Detroit ordains as follows:

- 11-1 The speed of motor vehicles, as automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, shall be limited to a speed not to exceed twenty miles (20) per hour on streets within the city limits of Detroit, Oregon, when such streets are so posted.
- 11-2 A sign designating the speed limit shall be posted at each entrance to the street.
- 11-3 This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the city of Detroit, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect when signed by the mayor.
