SECTION 1: Pursuant to ORS 221.770, the city hereby elects to receive state revenues for fiscal year 2000-2001.


Read aloud, in full, this 13th day of June 2000.

SECTION 4. FINES


A person who is ticketed and convicted of this Ordinance may be punished by a fine of not less than \$250.00 or more than \$750.00. Each day during which a violation exists will be considered a separate violation and offense. In addition, violation of this ordinance shall constitute a public nuisance and may be regarded as such in all actions, suits and proceedings. Said nuisances may be prosecuted in the courts of the State of Oregon.
