

ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CITY OF DETROIT ORDINANCE NO. 180 RELATING TO STATEWIDE MEASURE NO. 7; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Detroit adopted Ordinance No. 180 to accommodate the implementation of the Oregon statewide Measure No. 7 which, subsequent to the adoption of Ordinance No. 180, was enjoined from becoming effective by the Marion County Oregon Circuit Court;

WHEREAS, until the state law on the subject is resolved through the Court or otherwise, it is appropriate that the City of Detroit's related legislation be repealed;

WHEREAS, because the statewide Measure 7's implementation has been rendered, at least temporarily, ineffective, it is appropriate that the City of Detroit legislation be promptly repealed; and,

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that an emergency be declared as to the enactment of this Ordinance so that it is in full force and effect immediately from and after its adoption by the City of Detroit City Council.


NOW, THEREFORE the City of Detroit City Council does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: City of Detroit Ordinance No. 180 is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2: Upon adoption by the City of Detroit City Council and the Mayor's signing, this Ordinance shall become immediately effective.
