

ORDINANCE NO. 202

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 156

THE CITY OF DETROIT OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The purpose of this amendment is to amend the title, and the text in Section 1, amend the text in Section 2 (B), and deleting Section 2 (A) in Ordinance 156 dated June 5, 1998.

The title is hereby amended to read, 'An Ordinance Creating a Water System Reserve Fund'.

Section 1 and Section 2 are hereby amended to read,

SECTION 1. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a water systems reserve fund for replacement and expansion of the City Water System. This shall include, but is not limited to replacement of existing plant, water supply source, meters, water lines and electrical lines.

SECTION 2. Contributions

Annual contributions from the water fund shall be determined by the budget committee for a period of at least ten years to be reviewed to decide if it should be continued or abolished.

SECTION 3. Severability

Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase: and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held to be invalid on one ground is the one upon which the ordinance or such portion thereof was enacted.

SECTION 4. Emergency

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Common Council of the City of Detroit and approval of the Mayor.
