## ORDINANCE NO. 124

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 115

"The City of Detroit, Oregon ordains as follows:"

Purpose. The purpose of this amendment is to change the text in Section 7 (2) of Ordinance No. 115, dated June 8, 1993. Section 7 (2) is hereby amended to read:

(2) At the first meeting of each year the council shall choose from its membership a chairperson, who shall be mayor for one year; and the mayor shall appoint persons and positions required by the council to be so appointed. The mayor shall enforce the rules of the council, and determine the order of business. Except as otherwise provided by law and except where the Detroit City Council directs or acts to the contrary, Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised shall govern parliamentary processes of this public body.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase; and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held to be invalid on one ground, but valid on another it shall be construed that the valid ground is the one upon which the ordinance or such portion thereof was enacted.

Section 3. Emergency. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

Read first in full and by title only on Jebruary 8, 1994. Read a second time by title only on Johnson, 1994. Passed by a vote of bayes and O nays of the city council this 8th day of Jebruary, 1994.
