ORDINANCE NO. 128

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

AN ORDINANCE relating to participation by the CITY OF DETROIT in an intergovernmental agreement of the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments.

WHEREAS the City of Detroit desires to become a member of the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments (MWVCOG); and

WHEREAS the member governments of MWVCOG desire to revise and reform the Charter and Agreement by which the MWVCOG is created; and

WHEREAS ORS 190.085 requires that prior to the effective date of an intergovernmental agreement creating an intergovernmental entity, each of the parties to the agreement shall enact an ordinance ratifying the creation of the intergovernmental entity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Detroit, Oregon:

Section 1. That it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Detroit to create, along with the other parties to the agreement, an intergovernmental entity known as the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the effective date, specification of public purposes for which the MWVCOG is created, and the powers, duties and functions of the MWVCOG are as stated in the Agreement attached hereto and, by this reference, incorporated herein.

Section 3. That the said Agreement is hereby ratified and the Ordinance Bill - Page 1

Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to sign the same on behalf of the City of Detroit.
