## **ORDINANCE NO. 197**

## AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN CITY ORDINANCES; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there are certain City of Detroit ordinances that have been superseded by more current ordinances without being repealed, or are duplicative of other ordinances;

WHEREAS, the City of Detroit finds it necessary to repeal certain ordinances that have been superseded by more current ordinances or are duplicative of other ordinances:

WHEREAS, the Detroit City Council received recommendations from the Mid-Willamette Valley Council of Governments and the City Attorney to repeal certain ordinances that have been superseded by more current ordinances or are duplicative of other ordinances; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2004, the Detroit City Council conducted a public hearing to review the proposed repeal of certain ordinances;

WHEREAS, after required notice and public hearing, the City Council found that it is the City's desire to repeal certain ordinances that have been superseded by more current ordinances or are duplicative of other ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the Detroit City Council declare an emergency as to the enactment of this Ordinance so that it is in full force and effect immediately from and after its adoption.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DETROIT, OREGON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following ordinances are hereby repealed for their given reason:

- A. Ordinance #22 (unknown date 1958), as its purpose (Building Code) has been superseded with a more current ordinance. No known copy can be found.
- B. Ordinance #41A (March 12, 1968), as the Detroit Development Code (Ordinance #184) has superseded its purpose to regulate trailer houses and trailer parks.
- C. Ordinance #44 (May 12, 1970), as the Detroit Development Code (Ordinance #184) has superseded its purpose to regulate trailer houses and trailer parks.

- D. Ordinance #52 (April 10, 1973), as its purpose (regulate Water Department) has been superseded by another ordinance.
- E. Ordinance #54 (April 30, 1974), as its stated purpose, "Elections," cannot be determined. No known copy can be found.
- F. Ordinance #54A (July 9, 1974), as its purpose (regulate Water Department) has been superseded by another ordinance.
- G. Ordinance #96 (November 12, 1991), as it appears to be superseded by Ordinance #171 (April 13, 1999).
- H. Ordinance #165A (January 12, 1999), as it is an exact duplicate of Ordinance #174 of the same date.

SECTION 2. Upon adoption by the Detroit City Council and the Mayor's signing, this Ordinance shall become immediately effective.
