ORDINANCE NO 203

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 166 RELATING TO CITY FEES

WHEREAS, the Detroit City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Detroit to amend Ordinance 166 relating to fees and regulations regarding City Streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DETROIT, OREGON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Amend number 4, adding Patton Road, Santiam Avenue and Forest Avenue West of Highway 22 and Detroit Avenue N., which reads; the street in the City of Detroit known as Highway 22 shall be exempt from this ordinance regardless of weight. All vehicles regardless of weight may utilize this road. The streets in the City Of Detroit known as Detroit Avenue and Clester Road shall be exempt from this ordinance for delivery trucks only.</u>

Section 2. Remove number 5 which states: any person who is a legal resident of the City of Detroit may travel over any street or roadway in the City of Detroit and operate a vehicle having a gross vehicle weight according to the manufactures specifications in excess of 30,000 pounds when it becomes necessary to drive said vehicle to the residence of said person, in situations where said person who operates the vehicle is loaded and can not unload his vehicle, and therefore may keep said vehicle at his residence, but such allowed overnight parking may not exceed 12 consecutive hour in a 24 hour period on any property. At no time may vehicles be parked on City Streets.

<u>Section 3. Amend number 8:</u> <u>Remove</u> "there will be no charge for first 5 loads per month, each load thereafter will be charged \$25.00 per load ", and <u>add</u> "there will be no charge for the first load and a fee of \$30.00 per load be charged for each load exceeding 50,000, which will be for street revenue.

Section 4. Add number 9: The City of Detroit will charge a City permit Fee of \$25.00
