ORDINANCE NO. 227

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 222 (AMENDMENT TO NUISANCE ORDINANCE NO. 213) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on the 17 day of July 2010, the City of Detroit passed Ordinance No. 222, an Ordinance amending Ordinance 213, regarding noise disturbance regulations.

WHEREAS, the Detroit City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Detroit to amend Ordinance No. 222 regarding noise disturbance regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DETROIT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 222 is hereby amended by changing the text as follows:

"Music generated by electronic apparatus or live bands, amplified or unamplified, shall be permitted in the Downtown Business District until 12 Midnight on Friday and Saturday, and on Sunday when a Monday Federal holiday follows".

- **SECTION 2.** Amended Section 1 of Ordinance No. 222 shall become Paragraph 11. of Ordinance No. 213 Section 15 (E).
- **SECTION 2.** Except as specifically amended herein, Ordinance No. 213 shall remain in full force and effect".
- **SECTION 3.** EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
