## **ORDINANCE NO. 234**

## AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF CLESTER ROAD WEST LOCATED IN THE CITY OF DETROIT, OREGON, A RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE AREA

**WHEREAS**, Clester Road West is known to be a highly congested area during the summer season; and,

**WHEREAS**, the installation of a bicycle/pedestrian path eliminates vehicular parking on the north side of Clester Road, from the intersection of Patton Road to Kane's Marina; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Detroit believes it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Detroit, Oregon, to establish a restricted parking zone area along Clester Road West.

## NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DETROIT, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1**: Clester Road in its entirety is hereby declared a Restricted Parking Zone Area and shall be signed as follows:

1. North side: No Parking

2. South side: Permit Parking Only

**Section 2**: Parking along the south side of Clester Road is for the exclusive use of Clester Road residential property owners or lessee of the property who meet the following qualifications:

- Property owned or leased must be located along the south side of Clester Road West.
- 2. Property owner or lessee must obtain an annual address-specific permit (decal) from the City of Detroit and pay the \$45 processing fee for the first year, and \$10 each subsequent year. The fee includes a total of three (3) decals per address.
- 3. Property owner or lessee must complete an application form and show proof of residency.

<u>Section 3</u>: The Detroit Municipal Code states that no vehicle can be parked on city right-ofway for more than 72 hours. This ordinance is in effect for all citizens of the city, including Clester Road residents who hold a permit (decal).

**Section 4**: Federal, State, County, City, and emergency personnel on official business are exempt from restricted parking permit requirements.

**Section 5**: The City's Ordinance Enforcement Officers are charged with enforcement of the Restricted Parking Zone Area Ordinance. Per Enforcement Ordinance No. 207, violators are subject to a fine of up to \$250 per day/per violation.

Section 6:	This Ordinance shall take effect on MAY 1, 2015.
