ODINANCE NO. 255

A ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 235, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROVISIONS FOR THE KEEPING OF BACKYARD CHICKENS ON DEVELOPED SINGLE-FAMILY ZONED LAND, MULTI-FAMILY ZONED LAND THAT CONTAINS ONE SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING, AND COMMERICAL GENERAL ZONDED LAND THAT CONTAINS ONE SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Detroit City Council passed ordinance 235 on August 12, 2014. An ordinance allowing the keeping of backyard chickens; and,

WHEREAS, the Detroit City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Detroit to amend Ordinance No. 235 to keep backyard chickens permanently and to allow selling excess chicken eggs; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF DETROIT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 – Reads, the keeping of backyard chickens shall be permitted in certain zones within the city for the period beginning September 1, 2014 and ending August 31, 2016.

Remove, for the period beginning September 1, 2014 and ending August 31, 2016.

Section 2 – Section 1 K, reads, chickens may be kept and used only for personal, family and household use. No person shall sell chicken eggs.

Remove, no person shall sell chicken eggs.

Emergency Clause: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
