ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND DESIGNATING THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1964 EDITION AS THE BUILDING CODE ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF DETROIT. SAID ORDINANCE TO BE KNOWN AS ORDINANCE NO. 35, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DETROIT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- 34-1. That the International Conference of Building Officials Uniform Building Code, 1964 Edition, and its amendments, is hereby adopted as the building code ordinance for the City of Detroit.
- That an emergency exists in that existing conditions in the City of Detroit are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety; and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
