ORDINANCE NO. 43 A

An ordinance emending Ordinance No. 42 of the City of Detroit entitled:

"AN (RDINANCE regule ting, as authorized by ORS 215,110, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area and maintenance of buildings and structures in the City of Detroit, Oregon; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for the violation thereof; providing for appeals; repealing Ordinance No. 34 & 35 and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith; and declaring an emergency.",

to require inspection and a permit for any waste disposal facility, and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF DETROIT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 42 of the City of Detroit

entitled "An ORDINANCE regulating, as authorized by ORS 215,110 enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area and maintenance of buildings and structures in the City of Detroit, Oregon; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for the violation thereof; providing for appeals, repealing Ordinance No. 34 & 35 and all ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith; and declaring an emergency.", is hereby amended by adding to

Section 10 of said ordinance a Section 10-A, as follows:

Section 10-A. Plans for any waste disposal facility or any part thereof must have the approval of the Marion County Health Department before a permit is issued, and a permit is required for any and all installation, replacement, alteration, or substantial repair of any septic tank, field or lateral line, and such installation, replacement, alteration or repair must be inspected and approved by said department before backfilling.

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council by unanimous vote and approved by the Mayor this 13th day of January, 1970.
