ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2, 11, 49, 56 AND 84.

"The City of Detroit, Oregon" ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2. Regarding the office of recorder dated September 9, 1952 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 11. Regarding the speed of vehicles on posted city streets dated May 13, 1953 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 49. Regarding zoning regulations dated December 14, 1971 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 84. Regarding enforcement of city ordinances dated October 14, 1986 is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Ordinance No. 56. Regarding subdivision and land partitioning dated April 12, 1977 is hereby repealed.

Section 6. Severability. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase; and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held to be invalid on one ground but valid on another, it shall be construed that the valid ground is the one upon which the ordinance or such portion thereof was enacted.

Section 7. <u>Emergency</u>. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon it's passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
