ORDINANCE NO. 90

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLYING AN ORDAINING CLAUSE FOR ORDINANCE NO. 40 AND ORDINANCE NO. 85.

"The City of Detroit, Oregon" ordains as follows:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this amendment is to provide an ordaining clause for Ordinance No. 40 and Ordinance No. 85. The council, after reviewing the ordinances, has determined that it was intended to be adopted as a valid ordinance, but through error the ordaining clause was omitted. This amendment will ratify and reaffirm Ordinance No. 40 and Ordinance No. 85 by supplying the omitted ordaining clause, nunc pro tunc.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 40. Enacted October 10, 1967, is hereby amended to provide an ordaining clause as follows: "The City of Detroit, Oregon ordains as follows:"

Section 3. Ordinance No. 85. Enacted January 12, 1988, is hereby amended to provide an ordaining clause as follows: "The City of Detroit, Oregon ordains as follows:"

Section 4. Severability. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase; and if this ordinance or any portion thereof should be held to be invalid on one ground but valid on another, it shall be construed that the valid ground is the one upon which the ordinance or such portion thereof was enacted.

Section 5. Emergency. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon it's passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
