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- I. Council Roll Call** -Councilors Tesdal, Smith, Nielsen and Mayor Page were present with Councilors Sheppard and O'Donnell absent with notice.
- II. Approval of the Agenda** – Councilor Nielsen made a motion to approve the agenda and Councilor Tesdal seconded. All present in favor, with Councilors Sheppard and O'Donnell absent with notice.
- III. Special Orders of Business -**
 - a. Discussion – Moving Public Works to 2-bay at City Hall – It was suggested to clear out any things/equipment that is not working or broken. The councilors would like to have some organization in the new Public Works office such as shelves, cabinets and/or containers. Because of the glass doors it needs to be kept tidy. Marion county will not be using the bays for boat storage so the Public Works department will have the entire area.
Councilor McCall stated that it would be a good idea to have a work session at the shop to prioritize the organization and the needs of the bays. The suggestion was to do it at 3:00PM the afternoon of the next City Council meeting.

There was a question on whether the old water treatment plant equipment will be stored in the bays. The mayor is waiting to find out what the insurance company will do with the current plant after the new one is built.

The defibrillator had been missing the paddles when Councilor Sheppard had a heart attack and Councilor Tesdal asked if it had been fixed. It was stated that Nancy Powell supplied the paddles and it was now complete.

There was also discussion about painting the bathroom. Councilor McCall will get 3 bids and will provide them when he gets them.
